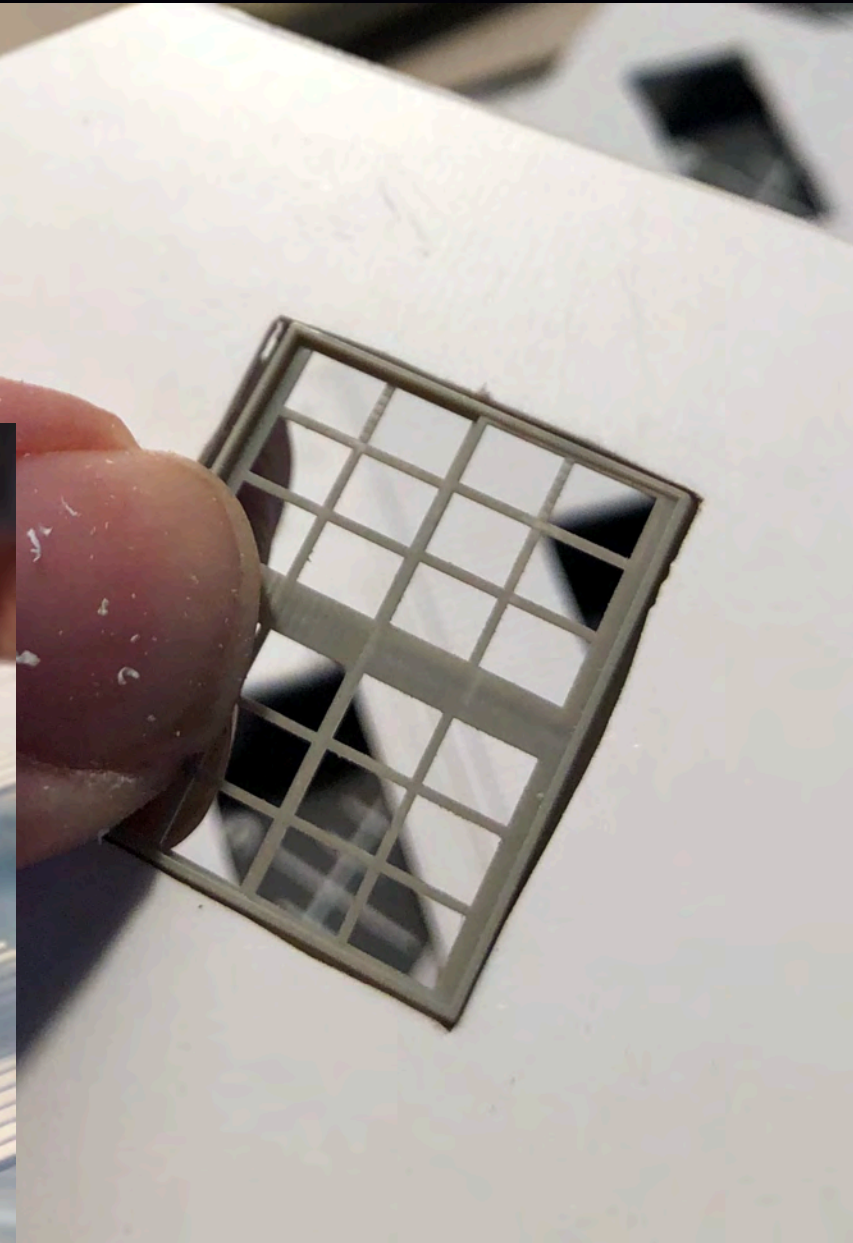
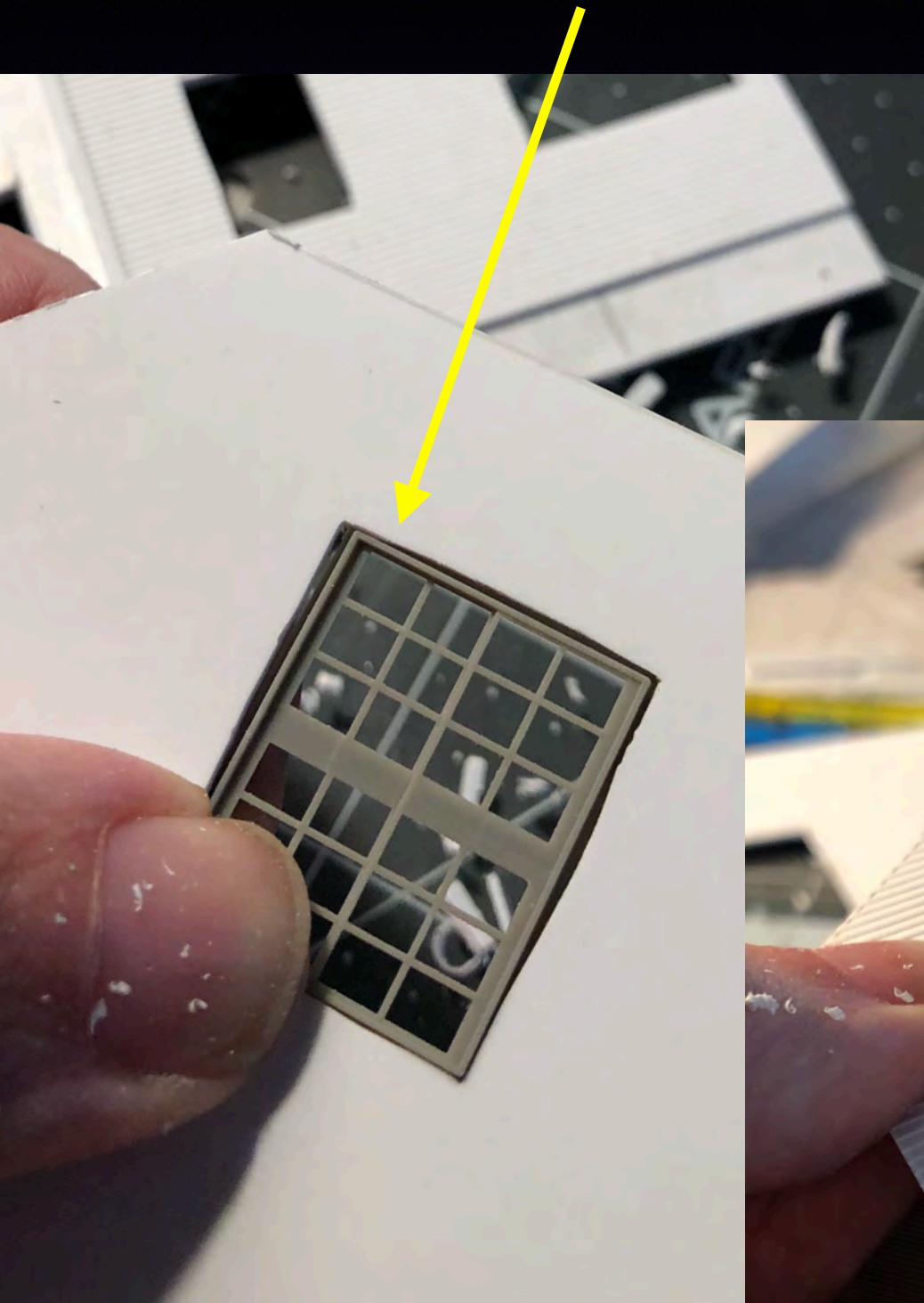


# Fit Windows and Doors



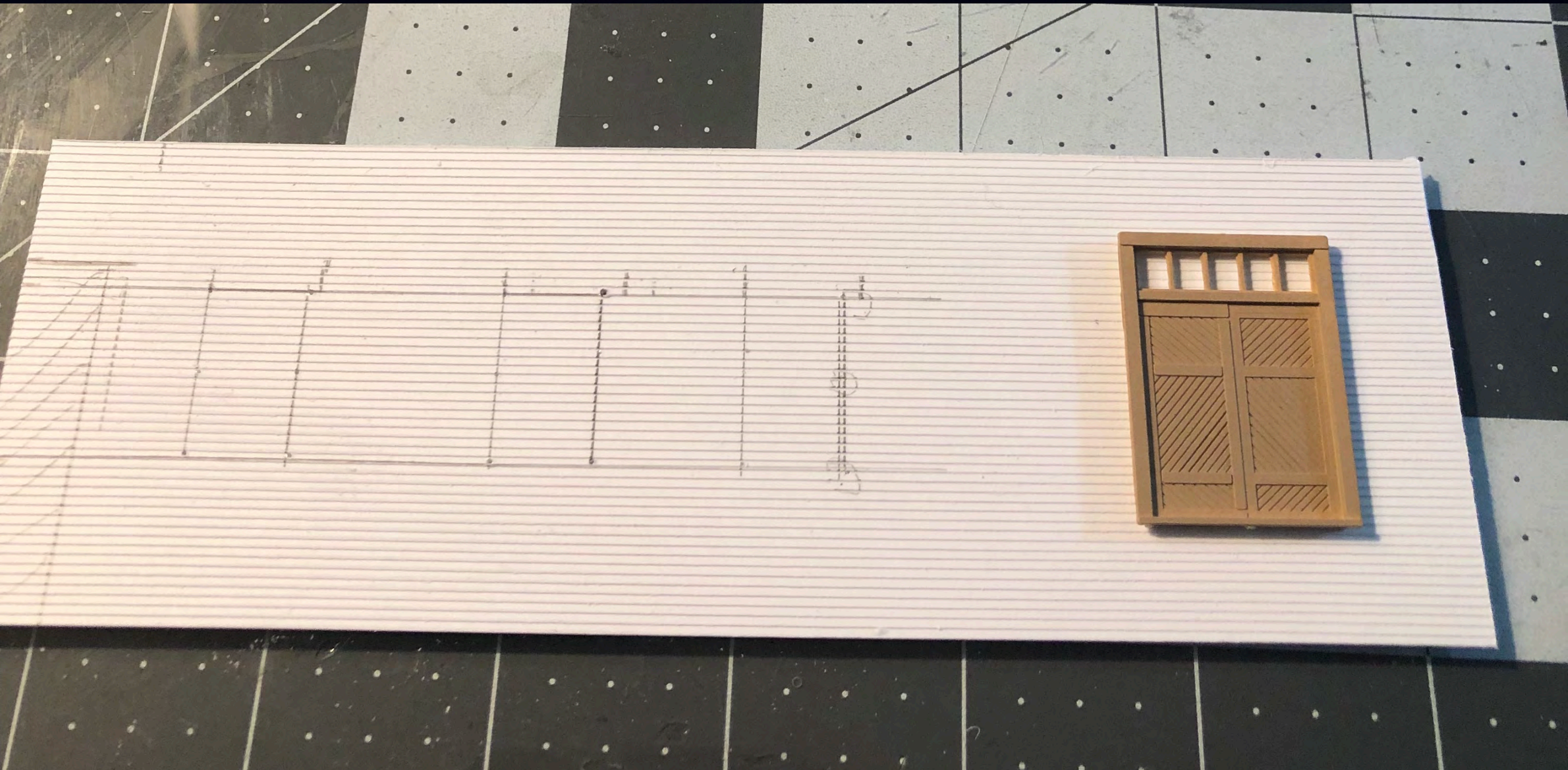


**Too tight in this corner**





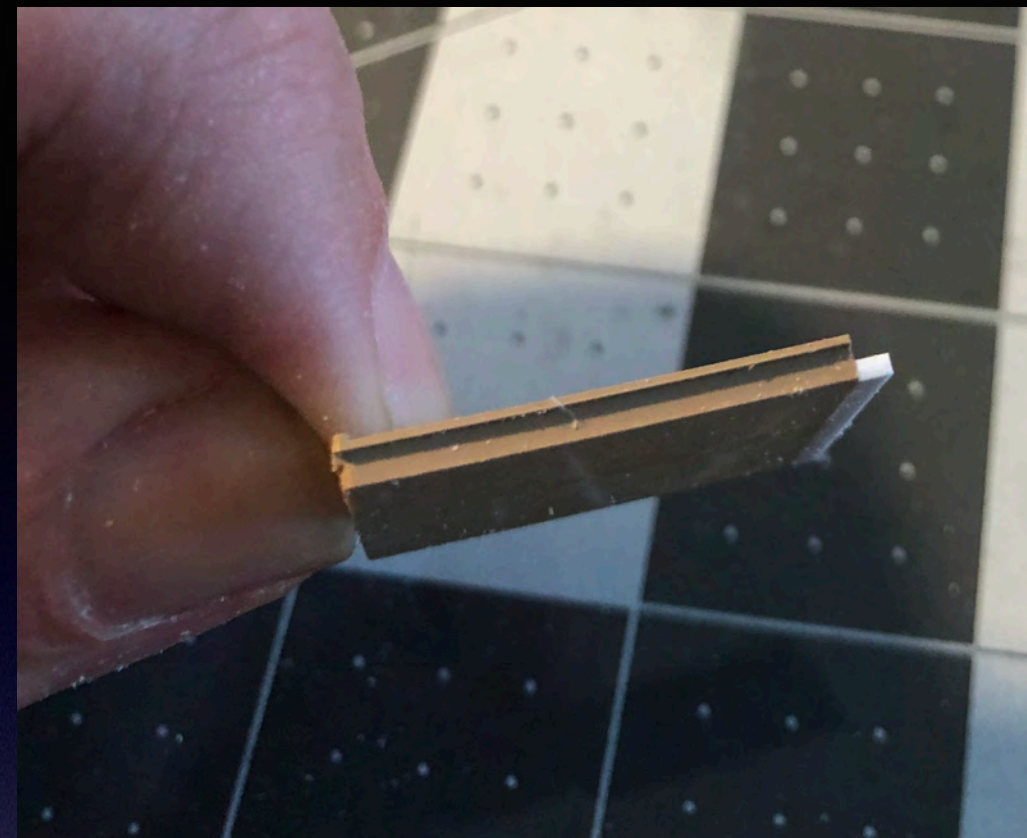
# Making and Modifying Doors and Windows

- This is just a piece of O scale passenger car siding with a Plastruct channel “rail” and a couple of Tichy hinges from a boxcar set













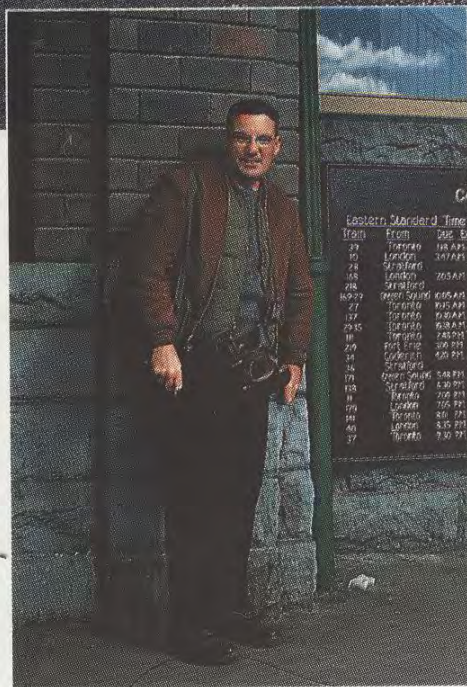

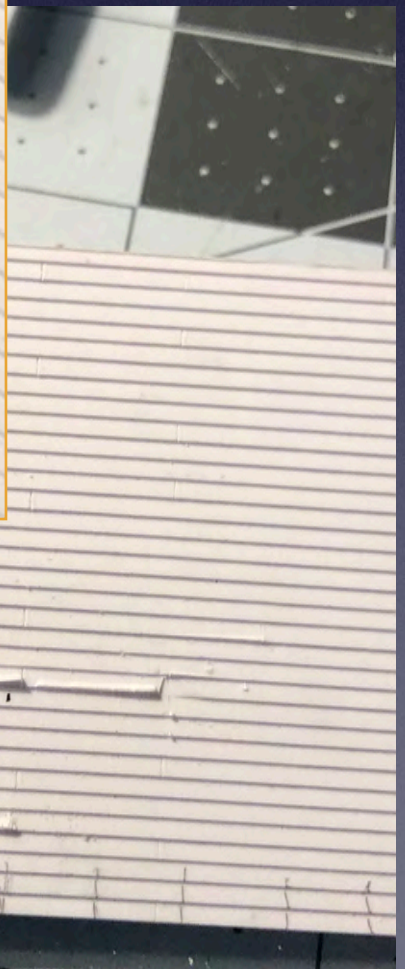
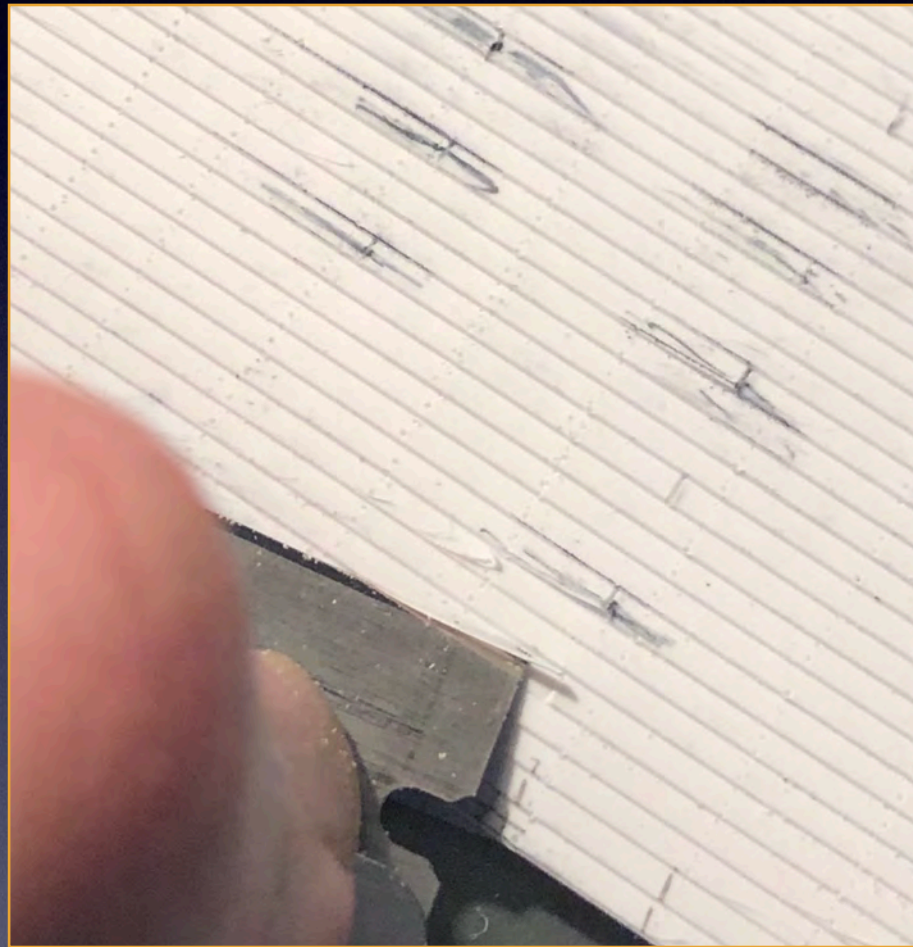
# Unpainted Wood - Start with Wood

**Followed by drybrushing . . .**





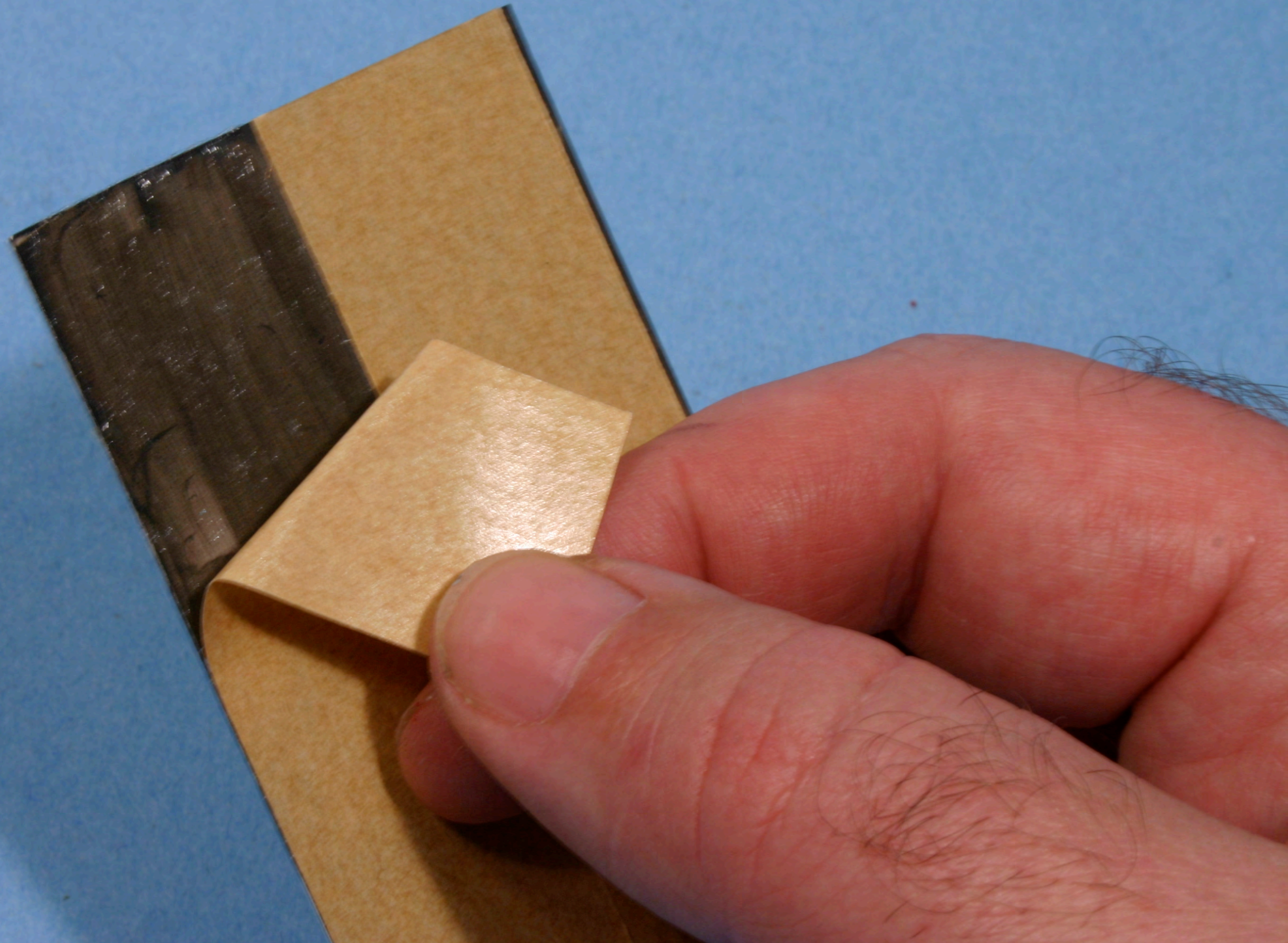








**Use double sided tape to adhere roofing material**





# Rolled roofing (“tarpaper”) made from ... paper (or wrapping issue)





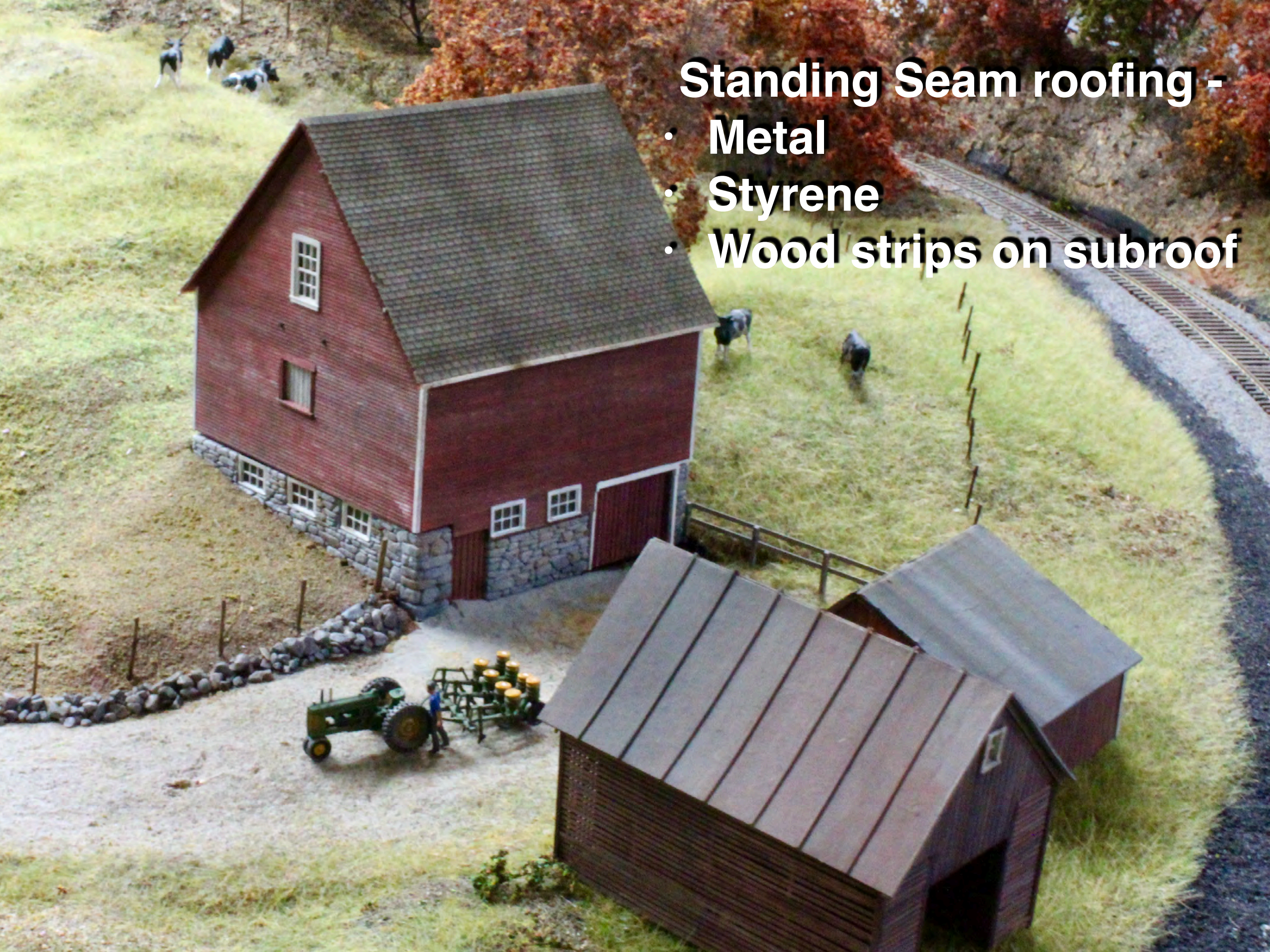


- **Shingles/Shakes/Slate - offered by many manufacturers - personally I prefer BEST Trains products**

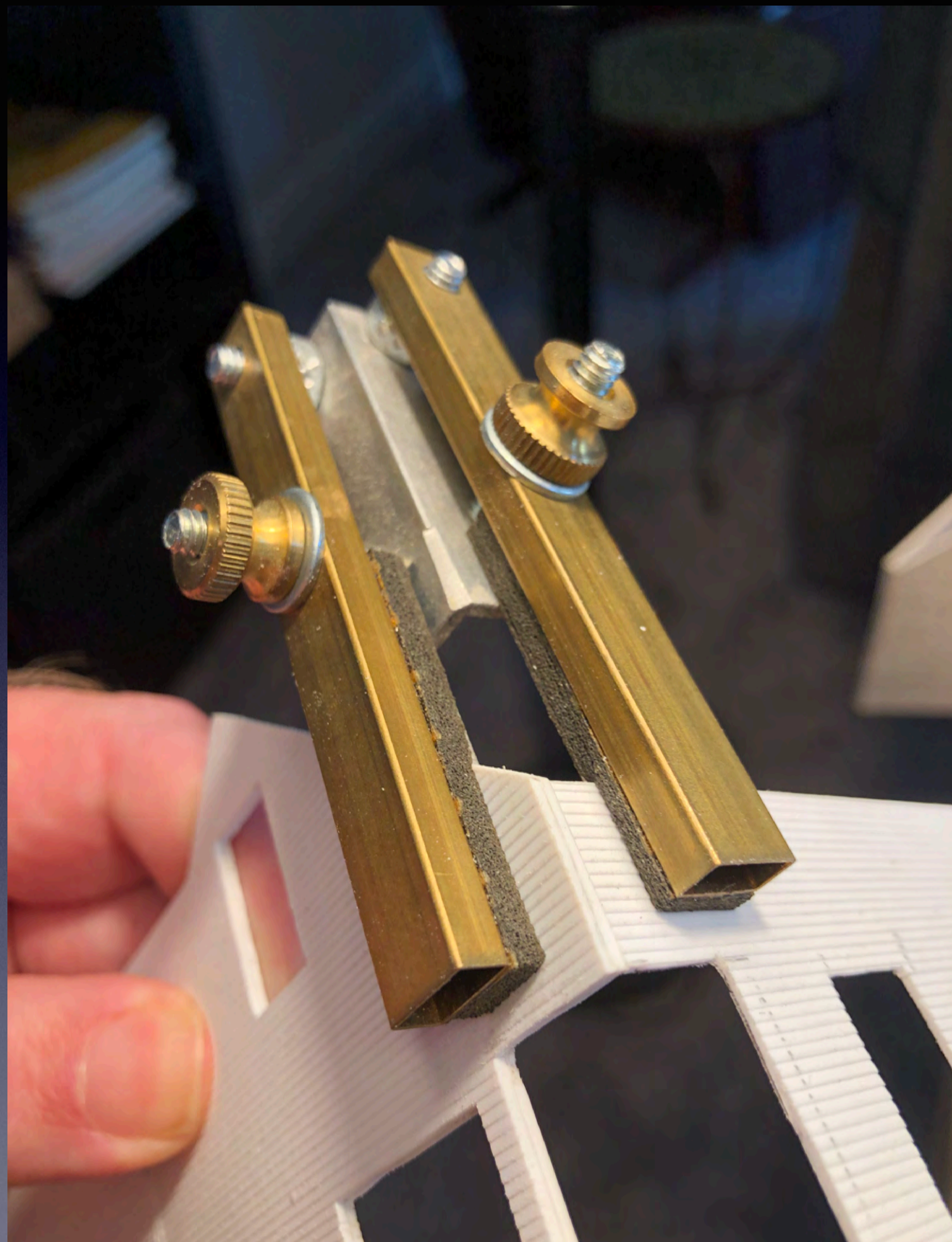

or 6x6**



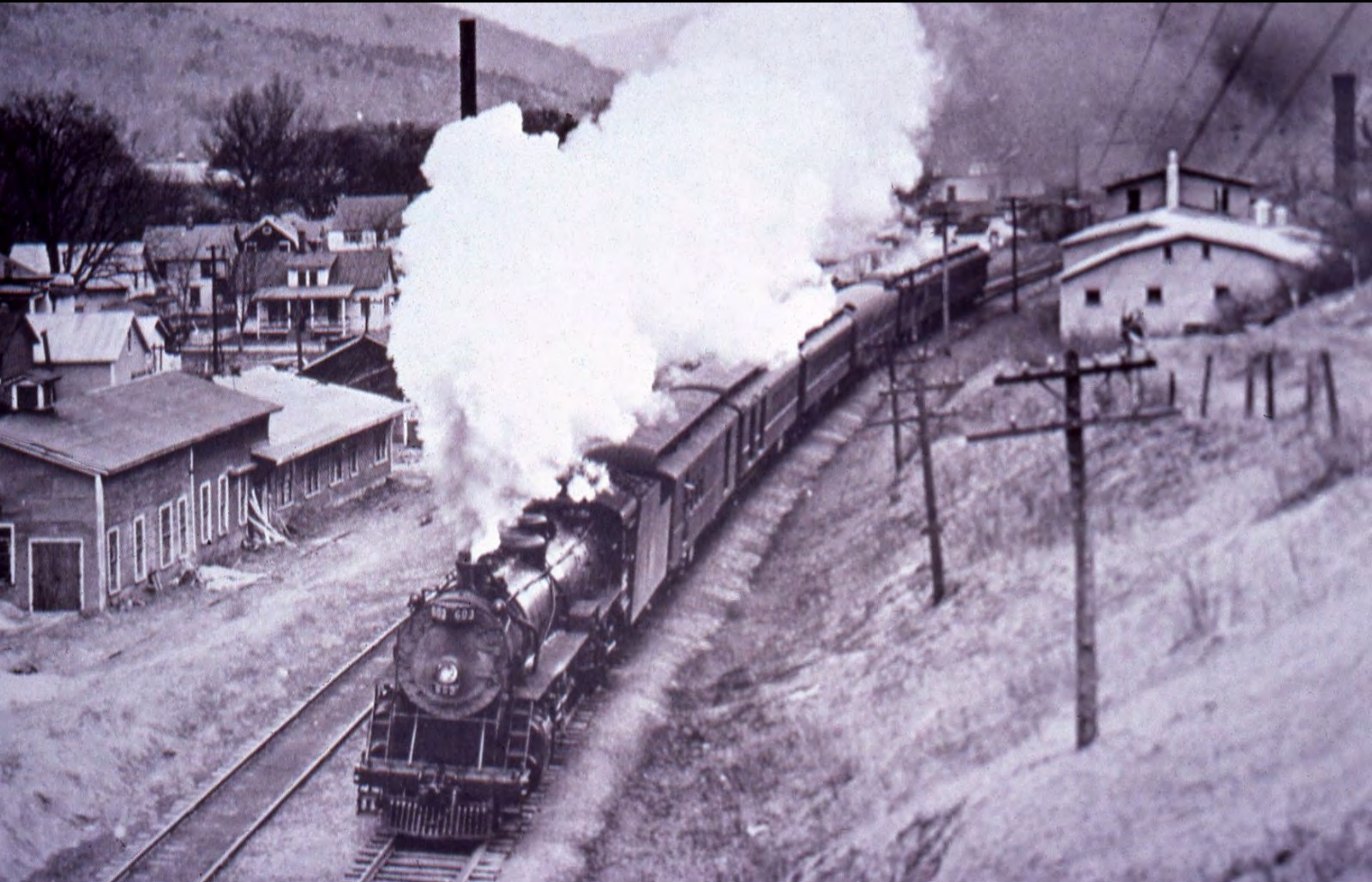




**Additions, lean-to's sheds, etc....**

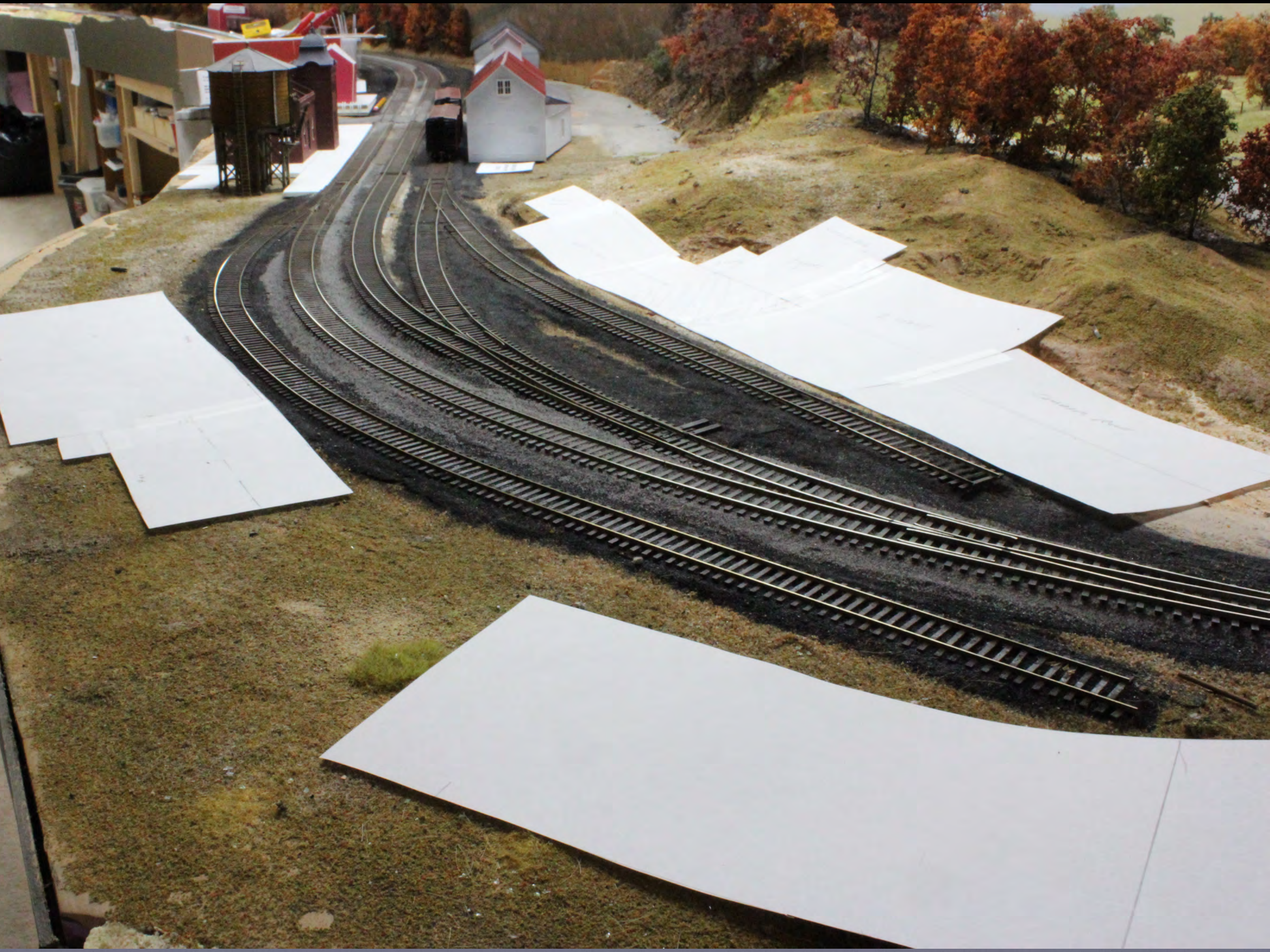
